



NOTES:

1. STAKES TO BE SET ON EAST & WEST SIDES OF TREE. SINK INTO UNDISTURBED SOIL.
2. ROUND WOOD STAKES SHALL BE OF A HEIGHT APPROPRIATE TO SUPPORT TRUNK OF TREE AND TO ALLOW TIES TO BE SET ABOVE THE POINT WHERE THE TREE BENDS NATURALLY. IN SOME CASES THIS MAY REQUIRE A STAKE TALLER THAN 8'.
3. TREE TIES SHALL BE CORDED RUBBER TIES NAILED TO THE BACK OF STAKE OR FASTENED WITH WIRE TIES FOR ADDED STRENGTH AND SHOULD BE INSTALLED ABOVE POINT WHERE TREE BENDS NATURALLY WHEN HELD BY HAND. DO NOT ALLOW TREE TO RUB AGAINST STAKES.
